1	A5. Health and safety	During the current assessment, it was noted that the factory has obtained Building approval plan from the local authority (Union Parishad) and not from the concerned authority (RA, UK), as per the current government requirement. Further, factory has not obtained any building approval plan for Building-2.	6 Months
2	A5. Health and safety	During the current assessment, it was noted that the factory fire license has not covered all areas. Building-2 (currently used as generator and sub-station, compression & staff dining hall) was not covered under the existing fire license.	3 Months
3	A5. Health and safety	During the current assessment, it was noted that the factory has not obtained floor layout plan from concern authority for Building-2 and Dining hall short	3 Months
4	A5. Health and safety	During the current assessment, it was noted that for almost 60% of the factory premises was not installed with industry graded emergency lights.	2 Months
5	A5. Health and safety	During the current assessment, it was noted that factory has not installed any fire rated / crush-bar doors in the premises. All doors were found either cavity walls or shutter types.	6 Months
6	A5. Health and safety	During the current assessment, it was noted that factory has not installed any fire hydrant system in the premises.	6 Months
7	A5. Health and safety	During the current assessment, it was noted that boiler and compressor was running from the ground floor and inside the production unit without fencing. Further, 2 electric bolts was running from the 4th floor of the main production building.	3 Months
8	A5. Health and safety	During the current assessment, it was noted that goods were stored improperly in the fabric store, accessories store and finished goods area with excessive height.	1 Month
9	A5. Health and safety	During the current assessment, it was noted that wastage (cute, poly, paper, etc) was stored on roof top.	6 Months
10	A5. Health and safety	During the current assessment, it was noted that insufficient certified firefighters in the premises. Factory has 40 certified fire fighters instead of 562. Further, firefighters were not properly trained on firefighting procedure. Though the factory had provided both internal and external training to them but the trained fire fighters were not conversant with the firefighting equipment & emergency response procedure.	3 Months
11	A6. Decent Working hours	During the current assessment, it was noted that the factory has exceeded the weekly working hours limit of 60 hours/week. In the months of November-2014, February 2015 and April 2015, the workers of all sections had worked an average of 66 hours/week to a maximum of 76 hours/week (including weekly off day). Further, the maximum daily working hour was recorded as 13 hours.	6 Months
12	A6. Decent Working hours	During the current assessment, it was noted that one day weekly off is not honored to by the factory. In the months of November 2014, February 2015 and April 2015, the workers of all sections had worked on a minimum of 2 to a maximum of 3 weekly off days. This resulted in continuous work of 13 days (January 21st 2015 to February 12th, 2015) without a break. Further, work on weekly off day is considered as overtime and workers were not getting a substitute day off.	6 Months
13	A6. Documentation	During the current assessment, it was noted that the factory has formed a Participation Committee - PC with comprising of 67 members. However, newly recruited workers could not recognize the PC members in the floor and also not aware about their role and responsibility.	3 Months
